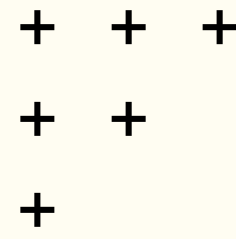
## RE-ALIGN TO GOD'S MISSION
