

Sin Concealed



Physical: bones wasted away, (Ps. 51- bones broken), strength dried up, sleeplessness

Mental/Emotional: sadness, depression, anxiety, fear, loneliness

Spiritual (Ps. 51:7-12): uncleanness, wrong spirit, broken relationship with God, lost joy

To acknowledge or admit our sin To agree with God about our sin

Confession of sin without the assurance of pardon leads to being stuck in guilt and shame.





Forgiven: taken away – We don't carry it anymore

Covered: removed from sight – God doesn't see it anymore

Not counted: God doesn't hold it against us anymore
